“Esperanto”

(WASHINGTON) The international language Esperanto combines the best features of many languages to form a simple yet powerful language for international use. As a second language for everyone, it can lead to international understanding.

Politically Neutral

(NEW DELHI) Esperanto belongs to everyone, not just to people of a particular nationality. It is acceptable everywhere. Esperanto allows every land to protect its native culture from the incursions of a foreign language. Often called “the international language *that works!*”

Easy to Learn

(PEKING) Esperanto was designed to be easy to learn. You can learn it *four to ten times faster* than most languages. Esperanto’s grammar, spelling, and pronunciation are all highly regular, reducing memorization. Its vocabulary is related to English, Spanish, German, Italian, so much of it will be immediately recognizable. The reusable suffixes help you multiply your vocabulary.

Used by Millions

(BRASILIA) About two million people, in over eighty countries, speak Esperanto. Tourists, pen pals, and participants at international conventions use it. Many people sample other cultures through the thousands of Esperanto books and magazines.
